

Comic Strip Directions

1. Write your name and the date on the "My Comic Script" worksheet.
2. Complete the "My Comic Script" worksheet.
3. Bring your "My Comic Script" worksheet to the teacher, and have her check off your worksheet.
4. Once the teacher has checked of your worksheet, you are now allowed to start creating your comic strip.
5. Get a computer from the computer cart, and turn it on.
6. Get on the internet, and go to <http://www.makebeliefscomix.com/>.
7. Once you are on the homepage, click the "Enter Here" button.
8. You should now be on the screen to create your comic strip.
9. Your job is to turn the information that is on your "My Comic Script" worksheet into a comic strip that you create.
10. Your comic strip must include: the definition of a factor, the definition of a multiple, your first number and its factors, and your second number and its first five multiples.
11. After you have created your comic strip, click the Print/Email button on the lefthand side tool bar.
12. Click the Print button under step #2, click OK, and then click print.
13. Write your name and date on your comic strip, and bring it to the teacher.
