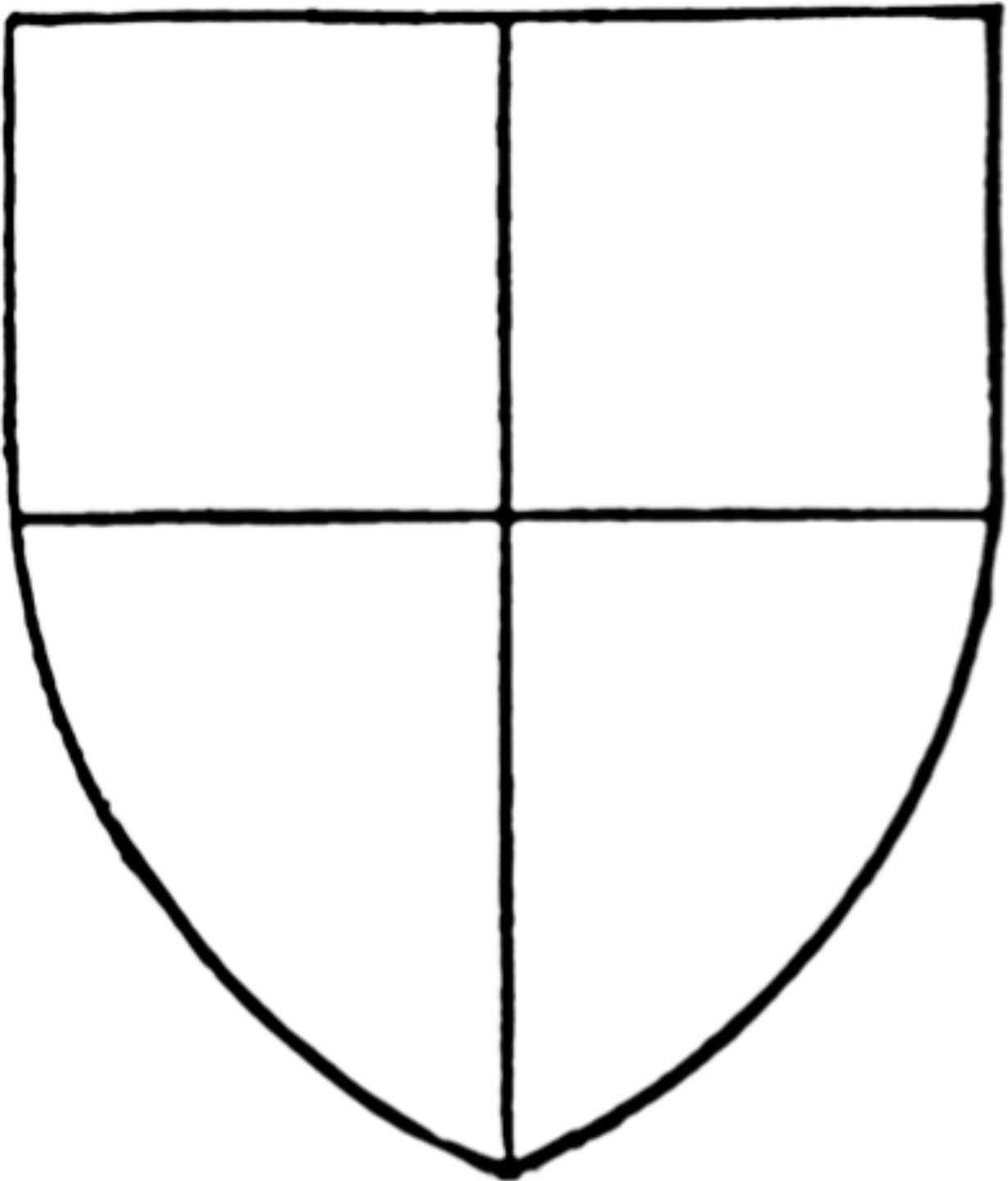


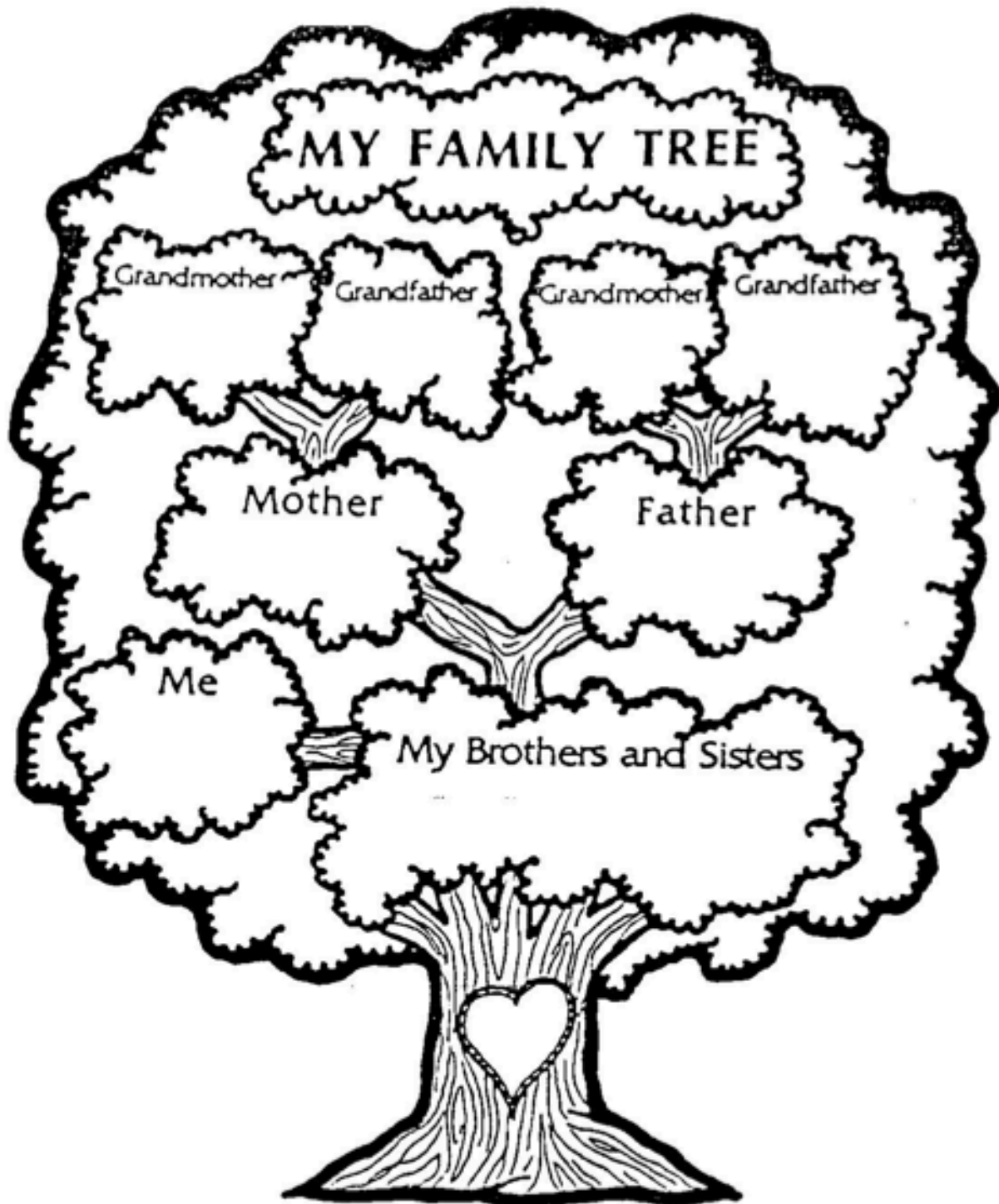
A Coat of Arms has long been a symbol of a family's identity and values. Make your own personal family crest based on the values and principles important to you.

1. Ask everyone to brainstorm ideas about what each section of your shield will include.
2. In the first section, draw a family flag that represents your family background.
3. Choose two important family values-such as truth, loyalty, love, or patience.
4. In the second and third sections, draw an illustration that represents the values you chose.
5. In the fourth section, get creative and choose something that is unique to your family to illustrate.
6. Cut out your family's crest and include in you museum exhibit.

1. Fill in the tree. You can choose to include pictures of each family member.
2. Color the tree
3. Cut out your tree and include it in your exhibit
